GENERAL INFORMATION

LINK-N24 provides (1) quick response from nitrate, (2) longer lasting nutrition from ammoniacal nitrogen, and (3) sustained feeding from controlled release nitrogen and water soluble organic nitrogen in the urea. The controlled release nitrogen reduces burn potential normally associated with urea products.

LINK-N24 is complexed with 0.6% humates that are derived from Leonardite. It provides year-round green up and meets the nitrogen needs of over-seeded grass in winter.

LINK-N24 is an integral part of a customized liquid and granular fertilizer program. For maximum results, use LINK-N24 with WILBUR-ELLIS COMPANY'S other liquid and granular products.

LINK-N24 is compatible with:

- other fertilizers
- ammonium phosphate solutions, such as 10-34-0, 11-37-0, 9-31-0
- Potash solutions and combinations of potash and ammonium phosphate solutions
- many herbicides.

NOTE: Consult pesticide label or manufacturer or jar-test before mixing LINK-N24 with pesticide chemicals.

LINK-N24 should be used as part of a comprehensive Total Nutrition System® for optimizing plant growth, development, yield and quality.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LINK-N24 may be applied as a foliar spray by air, ground concentrate or dilute. Maintain agitation to provide uniform distribution within spray tank. Use of a high quality CPDA approved spreader, such as R-11®, at recommended rates to improve spray cover is usually advised. Do not apply when plants are under excessive heat or moisture stress. Applications of foliar nutrients to leafy vegetables or soft-skinned fruits during periods of excessive temperatures may cause cosmetic injury. Applications of certain micronutrients to fleshy fruits within 30 days of harvest may result in staining of rind or skin.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

Cool Season Turf: Bentgrass, bluegrass, fescue, ryegrass and other cool season grasses. Apply 4-8 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. in a minimum of 1 gallon of water.

Warm Season Turf: Bermuda grass, St. Augustine, Zoysia and other warm season grasses. Apply 4-12 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. in a minimum of 1 gallon of water.

Herbaceous Plants: Including annual and perennial flowers. Apply 1 gallon per 100 gallons of water. Spray to the point of run-off.

Trees: Apply 1-2 pints per 100 gallons of water and spray to cover.

Sprinkler Injection: LINK-N24 is meant to be injected in small amounts on a regular basis. For maximum performance of LINK-N24, inject with LINK MULTI-MIX.

For nitrogen deficiency, apply 12-16 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. For maintenance, use 4-8 oz. per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply 3-4 applications per month as tissue analysis warrants.
